What is IXL:

IXL is an online practice program. This program will allow us to individualize the learning experience for students so that they can work at their own pace to reinforce the essential content necessary for the upcoming school year.

How to sign in: Your child can sign in by visiting www.IXL.com on any computer and entering the username and password provided in class. There are even iPad and Android apps to allow your child to practice on the go.

Assignments: The following are the assignments to be completed with a minimum smart score of 80. The Smart Score considers not only the number of questions a student has answered correctly and incorrectly, but also the difficulty of the problems and the student's ability to answer correctly with consistency. **IXL objectives completed during the 2023-2024 school year will be deleted by June 1.**

The Summer Math Assignments can be found under the current **Learning Tab** for **4th Grade**. Please keep in mind that IXL routinely changes the letter categories and skill numbers over the summer. To avoid confusion, students must search for the correct skill by using the 3-digit code following the assigned skill as instructed in class and displayed below:
